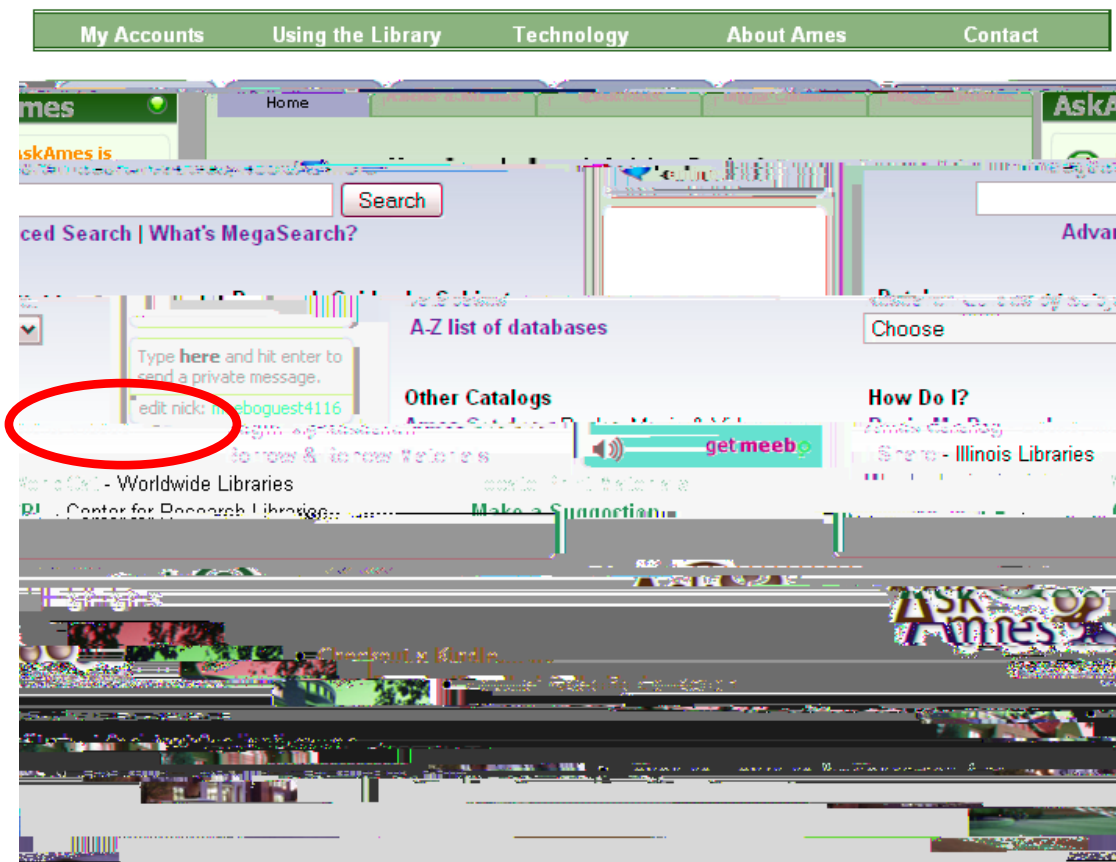


## The Book Arts Collection

The Book Arts Collection consists of volumes selected as examples of the art of book binding, illustrating, and printing history from the 12<sup>th</sup> century to the present. These books are located in the Ames Library Tate Archives & Special Collections on the **fourth floor** and are **not available for checkout**. The books may be consulted in the Archives Reading Room.
