

Chiropractors treat patients with health problems with nerves, bones, muscles, ligaments, and tendons. They use spinal adjustments and manipulation, as well as other clinical interventions, to manage patients' health concerns, such as back and neck pain.

Chiropractic Centralized Application Service (ChiroCAS; [www.portal.chirocas.org](http://www.portal.chirocas.org)) outlines critical dates for the application cycle. However, check with the application service and chiropractic schools of interest for deadlines.

Many chiropractic schools do not require any standardized test for admission. However, depending on the school, the Chiropractic College Aptitude Test (CCAT) is a requirement.
