Catalog Year

Some Possible Benefits to Changing Catalog Year:

Beginning in Fall 2022, the limit of courses that may count toward the degree from within a department (14 units) was removed.

Beginning Fall 2023, changes were made to allow addi onal scores in AP, IB, CAM classes (elec ve credit only) and to allow chairs to count the higher scores in majors/minors.

Beginning in Fall 2024, the Physical Educa on requirements were lowered.

In addi on, new majors/minors are o en added which requires switching to the newer catalog year in order to declare those.

Keep in mind that if the catalog year is changed, it will update ALL majors/minors to that catalog year.

You may view which catalog year a student is currently under by looking at the top informa on box on the audit (see picture at right).

Reasons to Avoid Changing Catalog Year:

There are a few reasons you may need to avoid changing catalog year:

- 1. Majors/minors may be rem J) A does not exist.
- Major/minor requirements are updated. It may be dicult for a student to complete the new requirements of the major/minor if they have been working toward a previous catalog year's requirements.

We have updated the audit every year based on catalog changes. However, if you see anything that looks like it doesn't match the catalog, please contact the Registrar's O ce. Keep in mind if the student is in an older catalog, their requirements will reflect the older requirements.
