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Encountering Diversity requirements: When choosing courses to fulfill IWU General Education, students should choose one G (Global Diversity) course and one U (Encountering U.S. Diversity) course to meet Encountering Diversity requirements.

AP and IB: AP scores of 4 or higher and higher level IB scores of 5 or higher can be used to meet General Education requirements at IWU. If scores were used to meet major content requirements, equivalent hours within the major will be required.

Remedial Math: Remedial math courses may be needed to prepare for MATH 161. However, remedial courses will not transfer to IWU. Adjust schedule and semester hour requirement accordingly to complete degree.

Ensuring Sufficient Coursework for Timely Graduation:

Students must complete a minimum of 64 semester hours, not including remedial courses or equivalent PE courses, at HCC to be on track to complete their bachelor's degree in a total of four years.

Students are required, at a minimum, to complete 16 units of coursework at IWU including half of all major requirements.

Graduation requirements: 32 total courses and 32 total units, 9 courses and 9 units of upper level courses, and 18 courses and 18 units of courses outside the major. Adjust schedule accordingly to complete these requirements.

1 IWU unit = 4 semester hours
